

## Details of Curriculum

### Learning Stages

Stage	Grades	Age Group	Focus
Foundational	Pre-K to 2	3-8 years	Stories, play, letters, numbers
Preparatory	3 to 5	8-11 years	Reading, writing, and group work
Middle	6 to 8	11-14 years	Subject understanding and skills

Each stage builds on what came before it. Students move ahead without feeling stressed. Teachers also get time to understand each child's progress and support them better. The structure also encourages students to ask questions and think clearly.

### Subjects in the Syllabus

The syllabus includes academic subjects along with personal growth. Each subject adds something different to the student's skill set. It begins with basic concepts and then moves to advanced topics in the middle classes.

- English and Hindi
- Mathematics
- Environmental Studies or General Science
- Social Studies
- General Knowledge
- Art and Music
- Computer Studies
- Physical Education

Students learn through stories, easy tasks and practical activities. Teachers help them speak, write and solve problems in small groups.
