Details of Teachers Training.

CRC training for teachers refers to in-service capacity-building programs and workshops organized at the sub-block level to provide academic, technical, and pedagogical support to improve classroom instruction.

Key aspects of CRC training include:

Purpose: To empower teachers through training, mentoring, and sharing best practices.

Focus: It addresses pedagogical issues, curriculum implementation, and school development.

Facilitator: The training is often organized by the Cluster Resource Centre Coordinator (CRCC).

Systemic Role: CRCs serve as a link between schools and higher authorities (like BRCCs or DIETs) for regular, on-site support.
